This book details how wrought iron was used in Norwegian Viking ships, STAR OF INDIA, D/S HANSTEEN, EUTERPE and other vessels of importance to maritime history and shipbuilding. This volume also includes an exciting account of Engvig's square sailing in his Viking longboat HITRA across the North Sea, navigating as the Vikings without navigational instruments. He also discusses various other aspects of iron ship preservation of special interest now that Titanic's iron rivets are discussed among maritime history buffs. Olaf Engvig also discusses the use of Viking gilded vanes.
